Ok the below is very sad but true this is not my words but documented facts:

Giving has not kept up with income, however. Protestant denominations have published data on an ongoing basis throughout the century. In 1916, Protestants were giving 2.9% of their incomes to their churches. In 1933, the depth of the Great Depression, it was 3.2%. In 1955, just after affluence began spreading through our culture, it was still 3.2%. By 2002, when Americans were over 480% richer, after taxes and inflation, than in the Great Depression, Protestants were giving 2.6% of their incomes to their churches. Giving as a portion of income to Benevolences was at the lowest point in the 1968-2002 period. During the same 34-year interval, U.S. population increased from 200,745,000 to 288,240,000, an increase of 44%. Therefore, while this church member grouping represented 14.1% of the U.S. population in 1968, it included 10.7% in 2002, a decline of 24% from the 1968 base. Benevolences declined from 0.66% of income in 1968 to 0.38% in 2002, decline of 41% as a portion of income. Out of the 34 two-year sets in the 1968-2002 interval, the portion of income that went to Benevolences declined 25 times, or 74% of the time. Pastor's Corner Judgement within the Body

Paul in his first letter to the Corinthians said. 1 Corinthians 5:12-13 (NLT) 12 isn't my responsibility to judge outsiders, but it certainly is your job to judge those inside the church who are sinning in these ways. ¹³God will judge those on the outside; but as the Scriptures say, "You must remove the evil person from among you." So many times we get side tracked with things we do not need to be sidetracked with. We must always use the scriptures as our measuring stick for all life's situations. As the world grows darker and darker we must remember Paul's words. This last month the world watched as a helpless woman was put to death by starvation. The country was divided by the situation. Most Christian's said it was wrong, the world said it was OK. The darkness of the world came out. People became so inflamed with this cause that one man put a \$200,000 bounty on the woman's husbands head. Many of the young people whom are called "the anarchists" used profanity to describe how disgusting to them it was this woman being allowed to live. The hatred that spewed from their lips really surprised me. We are seeing what my lovely wife has said for years "the hearts of many will wax cold". Mary found an article about how now some doctors have what they call an "exit policy" for the elderly. This secret policy is where the doctor now will decide if the elderly person should live or not without consulting the person or the family. They are just allowed to quietly pass away. The Muslims in Indonesia after the earthquake and tsunami in December told all the Christian and Jewish relief agencies to leave the area they did not want their help. Jesus said that we will be judged with the measure we judge. My friends as the world grows darker and darker we must look at it through the eyes of Jesus. It is a very hard thing but we must be humble enough to see the people of the world as Jesus saw them. We must never let our hearts grow hard with the pain and suffering we see. Paul also said in his first letter to Corinthians 1 Corinthians 4:10-13 (NLT) ¹⁰Our dedication to Christ makes us look like fools, but you are so wise! We are weak, but you are so powerful! You are well thought of, but we are laughed at. ¹¹To this very hour we go hungry and thirsty, without enough clothes to keep us warm. We have endured many beatings, and we have no homes of our own. 12We have worked wearily with our own hands to earn our living. We bless those who curse us. We are patient with those who abuse us. 13We respond gently when evil things are said about us. Yet we are treated like the world's garbage, like everybody's trash right up to the present moment. When I first read this I wept. I thought how could such a mighty man of God as Paul feel this way? Then I got a righteous anger and thought how could they treat him this way. But then I remembered that my Savior loved Paul so much that He let this humble man write most of the New Testament. If you study the great men of God in the Bible and throughout history you will find several important keys in their lives. First, they all were extremely humble. Three of God's greatest men Moses, David and Paul were murders. Luke 7:47 (NLT) 471 tell you, her sins—and they are many—have been forgiven, so she has shown me much love. But a person who is forgiven little shows only little love." The second thing you notice is their love of Jesus and His father. If we study the lives of just these three we see a total dedication to serving the Lord and His children. Oh, yes they were human and made mistakes. Moses had such a love for his fellow man that he accidentally killed a Egyptian. As these days grow darker and darker we must keep that love of Jesus in our hearts for mankind. We are told time and time again we must judge our fellow Christians, but not the world. Paul goes so far 1 Cor. 5:11 " do not even eat with such as these" referring to those who call themselves Christians and still live in sin. We are to be a royal priesthood, a chosen people, a holy nation. We are to stand out in this world of darkness. Not only are we to stand out we must stand out if the world is going to have any hope. If we spend our lives being "good" Christians attending Church etc., but we never give the little thirsty child a drink of water in Jesus' name, then what good are we to Jesus? The world needs the Love of Christ more today than ever before. Will you be the one to give it. Let's be totally different and serve them even as they spit upon us and curse us. No matter how dark and disgusting the world may grow we are to be a light and service to them. You will never truly know what it is to serve until you can say Paul's words. "We bless those who curse us. We are patient with those who abuse us. We respond gently when evil things are said about us. Yet we are treated like the world's garbage, like everybody's trash—right up to the present moment." Let's set the world on it heels by showing them we do not judge them, we love them just like Jesus did. Even if it means they hang us on a Cross like we did many, many years ago to another who loved the world.

This Months Bible Moment

But you will have saved your life because you did what you were told to do. You see Jesus told me that I was a watchman and I must speak the words he gives or your blood will be upon my hands. So if I am not uplifting or encouraging to you some months I am sorry, but I would rather not uplift you than let my Savior and Lord down.

For the ones that don't know, Chelsea is a friend from church that has cancer. She is in her 30's with 2 small children (Katie 9, Carson 8,)and her husband is Dwight. Very sweet, good, Christian family. Clayton is a 2 year old that is in my Sunday school class at church. His parents are Tracy and Greg. They too are a wonderful Christian family. Tracy took her little boy to the doctor with a tummy ache and fever and within hours they had in Little Rock Children's hospital. First for Chelsea (mother of 2) has been going through chemo for breast cancer. She is going to have a double mastectomy in a few more weeks. She was put in the hospital last Sunday night because of severe abdominal pains. They gave her pain medicine, but didn't know she was bleeding internally. One of her kidneys had ruptured. She has had to receive about 7 units of blood. She was put in intensive care and almost died Monday. They were going to do surgery to remove the kidney, but wanted to make sure the other kidney was working enough. Well, yesterday she was moved into a regular room, the bleeding stopped and her kidney has started working again. She may get to come home Monday and be able to continue her chemo. Our God is AWESOME!!!

Next, our Clayton, 2 years old, has been on chemo about 3 months now to shrink a tumor. He had a Wilm's tumor that had completely consumed one kidney and wrapped around the inferior vena cava (this provides the blood supply to the lower half of the body) and bottom part of his heart. They tried twice to operate and couldn't. The tumor was too big. He could have a heart attack and or stroke, or bleed to death during surgery. The good news is that the tumor is shrinking. It is about the size of a tangerine now. The bad news is that the thrombus (finger) that is in the inferior vena cava is not shrinking. Although it hasn't grown, either. Big concern-that the thrombus is different histology then the tumor and that it may not be responding to the chemo. The last ultrasound showed that the tumor had shrank to the size of a golf ball. They are hoping when it shrinks more that the vena cava(thrombus) will begin to shrink. Then they will try the surgery again. When I went in and saw him when he was in the children's hospital, his little tummy was so big and swollen and now the tumor is the size of a golf ball. When I prayed last night I told God "I know we are asking for a lot now, for two people at a time. Two very sick people that both need a miracle, but please God we are needing healing for both." Then today we get good news on both of them, within minutes a part. Awesome!!! Our God is Just Awesome. I can't begin to find words that could praise Him enough. Thank all of you for your prayers. Don't stop now. Chelsea and Clayton and their families still need our prayers. Will let you know more when things change. I Love all of you and God Bless. Hugs & Prayers, Marilyn

INSPIRING WORDS FROM THE PAST

Love and Gifts

An Address given by Mr . S. Wigglesworth at the Kingsway Hall Whitsuntide Convention, London, May, 1928 .

THANK God for the Word which comes to us afresh! Early this morning I was thinking and wondering if the Lord should speak through me (if I had to speak today), and I was strongly impressed that I should read to you the first Epistle of the Corinthians, and, the thirteenth chapter. I am so thankful to God that He has dovetailed this thirteenth chapter of Corinthians between the

twelfth and the fourteenth, because the twelfth chapter deals expressly with the gifts of the Spirit, and the fourteenth is on the lines of the manifestations and the gifts of the Spirit, and the thirteenth of Corinthians is the governor balls over the engine. If ever you see an engine working, you will find right over the main valve that lets in the steam, there are two little balls going round as fast as they can, and sometimes they go slowly. They open and shut the valve that sends in the steam to the pistons. These are constructed so that the engine does not run away.

I find that God the Holy Ghost in His remarkable wisdom has placed the thirteenth chapter right between these wonderful chapters that we love to dwell upon so much, the gifts. How wonderful, how magnificent they are, how God has given them to us that we may be useful, not ornamental, to prove in every case and under every circumstance we might be there right at the time with these gifts. They are enduement for power, they are expressive of His love, they are for edification and comfort to so many weary souls. We find that God brings these gifts in perfect order that the church may receive blessings, but how many people, how many of us have failed to come to the summit of perfection because the governor balls did not work well, because we were more taken up with the gift than the power that moved the gift, because we were more delighted frequently in the gift than the giver of the gift! Then it became fruitless and helpless and we were sorry, and it brought on rebuke sometimes, and sometimes we suffered, suffered much or suffered less.

FLOWERS OR WEEDS?

Truly, one will find that for which one seeks! Many people seek to know the worst about people and to; "repeat it" rather than look for the good and the Christlikeness! And looking for weeds, they are bound to find them. Looking for something to grumble about, something to criticize, they are almost sure to discover it! How much better to look for flowers! Is there anything good, anything holy, upright, noble, anything praiseworthy, or deserving of commendation? Think of these things, fill your arms full of flowers, seek only that, which, is pure and heavenly! Let other people gather the weeds, if they will, but make it your business to bring unto King Jesus and to His Holy Court arms filled with flowers of sweet fragrance.

TONGUES AND INTERPRETATION.

"The love that constraineth, the grace that adorns, the power that sustains, the gift that remaineth may be in excellence, when He is the Governor, the controller, the worker."

How I do thank God for the tongues and interpretation, because they introduce new vision, they open the larger avenue. Let it please Thee to-day, Lord, to show us how to work, and how to walk and not stumble.

THE GIFTS

Now beloved, the subject is far too big for anything like half-an-hour, but we will do all we can by the grace of God that we may say things that will live after we have gone away, for it is of such a necessity that we should receive the Holy Ghost in the first place, and then after receiving the Holy Ghost, we must be covetous for the gifts, and then, after receiving the gifts, may we never lose the fact that the gift is end trusted to us for bringing out favours of God to the people. For instance, Divine healing is a gift for ministering to the needs of the people, the gift of wisdom a word in season at the moment to show you just what to do; the gift of knowledge, or the word of knowledge is to inspire you because of the consecutiveness of the Word of God, to bring you life and joy this is what God intends. Then the gift of discernment. We are not to discern one another, but to discern evil powers and deal with them, and command them back to the pit from whence they came. The gift of miracles: God intends us to come to the place where we shall see miracles wrought. So God would have us understand that tongues are profitable only when they exalt and glorify the Lord. Then when interpretation is given. Oh! that we might really know what it means it is not to have beautiful sensations merely and think that is interpretation, but such that the man who has it does not know what is coming, for if he did, it would not be interpretation. Interpretation is not knowing what you are going to say, but it is being in the place where you say exactly what God says. So when I have to interpret a message, I purposely keep my mind from anything that would hinder, and say sometimes," Praise the Lord," and " Hallelujah," that everything shall be a word through the Spirit, and not my word, but the word of the Lord! Now I understand that we can have these Divine gifts so perfectly balanced by Divine love that they shall be a blessing all the time, but there is such a desire sometimes in the human to do something. How the people listen and long for Divine prophecy, just as interpretation comes forth; how it thrills, there is nothing wrong with it; it is beautiful. We thank God for the office and the purpose that has caused it to come, but let us be careful to finish when through, and not continue on your own . That is why prophesy is spoilt . At the end of the unction you use strange fire, at the end of the message you try to continue. Don't fail, beloved, because the people know the difference, they know that which is full of life, that which is the real thing. Then again, it is the same with a person praying. We love people to pray in the Holy Ghost; how we love to hear them pray even the first sentences because the fire is there, but what spoils the most holy person in prayer is that after the spirit of prayer has gone forth, they continue on, and people say, " I wish they would stop," and the church becomes silent . They say, "I wish that brother would stop; how beautifully he began, now he is dry! "He won't stop. A preacher once was having a wonderful time, and the people enjoyed it, but when he was through he continued. A man came outside and said to someone at the door, "Has he finished?" "Yes," said the man, "long since, but he won't stop! "May God save us this morning from that . People know when you are praying in the Spirit, why should you take time and spoil everything because the natural side has come to it? God never intended that. God has a supernatural side, and that is the true side, and how beautiful it is! People know sometimes better than us, and we would know if we were more careful. The Lord grant us this morning revelation; we need discernment, we need intuition. It is the life inside, it is the inside salvation, cleansing, filling, it is all inside. Revelation is inside, it is for exhibition outside, but always remember this. God's Son said so much when He said this, "The pure in heart shall see God." There is an inward sight of God, and it is the pure in heart that see God. "Lord keep us pure, so that we shall never block the way."

THE LOVE

Love is always in the place of revelation, but " Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass and a tinkling cymbal." "And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing." Now it is a remarkable fact that God intends us to be examples of the truth . These are Divine truths, and God means that we should be examples of these truths. Now beloved, it is lovely to be in the will of God. How many people would like to be nothing this morning? I absolutely refuse to be nothing. You notice I did not put my hand up, but I know you mean the same, and your heart is the same exactly. Now then, how may we be something? By just being nothing, by receiving the Holy Ghost, by being in the place where you can be operated by God and be filled with the power to operate. What it really means to have a language, a beautiful language as so many men have. There are men who are wonderful in language. I used to like to read Talmadge when he was alive; how his messages used to inspire me. Oh, this Divine power, it is wonderful to have the tongue of an angel so that all the people who hear you are moved by the language, but how I should weep, how my heart would be broken if I came to speak before you in beautiful language without the power! If I had an angel's language and the people were all taken up with what I should say, and then Jesus was not glorified at all, it would be all hopeless, barren and unfruitful; I should be nothing, but if I speak and say " Lord, let them hear Thy voice, Lord let them be compelled to hear Thy truth, Lord, anyhow, anyway hide me to-day", If a Scripture hurts you, read it until it does good then He becomes glorious, and all the people say, " We have seen Jesus! " When I was in California I spent many days with our dear Brother Montgomery when I had a chance. There was a man who lived in Fraser Valley. He had been saved, but he had lost his joy, he lost all he had. He wrote to Brother Montgomery and said, " I am through with everything. I am not going to touch this thing again, I am through ." Mr. Montgomery wrote to him and said, "I will never try to persuade you again if you will hear once. There is a man from England, and if you will only just hear him once, I will pay all expenses ." So he came. He listened, and at the end of the time he said to me, " This is the truth I am telling you . I have seen the Lord standing beside you, and I heard His voice. I never saw you even "I have a lot of money and I have a valley five hundred miles long. If you speak the word to me, I will go on your word, and I will begin and open that valley for the Lord ." I have preached in several of his places and God used him wonderfully to speak right through that valley. What I should have missed when he came, the first day, if I had been trying to say something of my own instead of the Lord being there and speaking His words through me . Never let us do anything to lose this Divine love, this close affection in our hearts that says, " Not I, but Christ, not I but Christ! " I want to say forget yourself and get lost in Him . Lose all your identification in the Son of God, let Him become all in all, seek only the Lord and let Him be glorified . You will have gifts, you will have grace, and wisdom. God is waiting for the man that will lay all on the altar, fifty-two weeks in the year, three hundred and sixty-five days in the year, and then continue perpetually in the Holy Ghost . Now beloved, I must stop; I would like to have gone on. I have such joy in this. I have had the joy of taking this chapter three times in my meetings, one hour every morning, and then giving out questions and answers. I would like something like that this morning, but beloved, go on for every blessing from the Lord that the Lord shall be large in you, that the wood and the hay and the stubble shall be burnt up and the Lord shall bring you to a great harvest time. Now beloved, shall we not present ourselves this morning to the Lord, that He may put His hand upon us and say, " My child, my child be obedient to the message, hear what the Spirit saith to thee that thou mayest go on and possess the land," and the Lord shall give thee a great inheritance.
