So now not only are the orphans being fed, clothed and given a place to live but they are also being given a computer education that will benefit them





in the rest of their school studies. Pastor Peter being a humble pastor did not want to ask for help in rebuilding the home that he and his family live in with 20 additional orphans. At my continuing request he put together a cost to rebuild this building. I cannot say why, except for the urging of the Holy Spirit I felt Pastor Peter's home needed the work. As we progressed we discovered what the next



photo shows. You can see pastor Peter by the base of the Home. We discovered that the base timbers that were holding up the house were rotted and it was only through the grace and power of our God that Pastor Peter's home did not collapse and kill at least 25 people. You see my friends when you are doing the perfect will of God you are protected. By new year those 20 orphans and Pastor Peter and his wife will have a safe home to live in because the Lord opened those doors and His Will Ministry stepped through.

Ok this was just the beginning. Pastor Yesudass in India of Paul Ministries

www.hiswillministry.org/paul is working with us to reach the tribal people including the Hindu's in his region. We just finished a project to reach the tribal children with special Christmas packages. Because of the fact that the area that Pastor Yesudass ministers to is very poor we are currently working on a planning phase of a sewing project. This project will give the local woman training on sewing clothes to be able to provide for their families. This facility would provide Christian teaching to hopefully create a whole new group of





women evangelists who will go forth and tell their friends, relatives, neighbors about what Jesus has done for them. We are hoping, praying that this facility will be able to become a totally self supporting ministry in its own. With growth of the textile industry in India this could be a very good project for the Kingdom of God and the very poor region. Pastor Yesudass is also working as our Pastoral representative in India with

many other ministries. He is our eyes and ears there.

Mary's Thoughts for the Month TEN BRIDESMAIDS

I was reading the parable of the ten bridesmaids in the book of Matthew today (Matthew 25:1-13). I love how Jesus was always such a story teller, I can picture just sitting at His lovely feet and listening to Him recount the parables to those who followed Him. In this particular instance He was using the analogy of a Jewish wedding ceremony something His listening audience could relate too. In the Jewish wedding ceremony the long-awaited Bridegroom (Jewish brides waited a year after betrothal for their Bridegroom to prepare a place for them) came to snatch away the bride the night before the wedding feast itself. This parable is one of the easiest ones to understand, the Bridegroom is of course Jesus, and the five wise virgins (bridesmaids) represent genuine believers, and the five foolish bridesmaids represent unbelievers. Remember that Jesus was talking to the Jews and often He employed using language that the Jews would understand, such as a Jewish wedding ceremony, but Jesus was also speaking to us, all of us who would believe in Him through the years.

Let's look at the verses from the Bible: Matthew 25¹"Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ²Now five of them were wise, and five *were* foolish. ³Those who *were* foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, ⁴but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. ⁵But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. ⁶"And at midnight a cry was *heard:* 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' ⁷Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. ⁸And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us *some* of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' ⁹But the wise answered, saying, '*No*, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' ¹⁰And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut. ¹¹"Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' ¹²But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' ¹³"Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

From reading these scriptures we can see that all are virgins, all of them have lamps, all of them go out to meet the Bridegroom, and all of them get drowsy and fall asleep. These are the things they have in common. This parable that Jesus told of the Bridesmaids is a microcosm of the church today. All believers should be waiting for Jesus to return, just as He promised He would. All of us should have our lamps and be ready to go out to meet Him. For all intents and purposes these virgins seem identical until you read that only five of them had enough oil to keep their lamps lit. What does this mean to you and me? All of the virgins fell asleep, because Jesus says that at midnight they all arose. But only five of them were properly prepared to meet the Bridegroom, five of them had stayed in a state of preparation and five had not. The five who were not prepared immediately tried to borrow oil from the five who were prepared in order to trim their lamps. There is one valuable

lesson to learn from this parable of the ten virgins and that is we must be ready every moment to meet Jesus Christ, our oil should be in our lamps. Many Christians today have grown weary of watching and waiting for the Lord to return it isn't uncommon for Jay and me to encounter people who say they believe in Christ who will mutter, "Where is the promise of His coming, even my grandmother believed she would see Christ's return." The reason I live in a state of readiness is because of Jesus' words here to the foolish virgins who showed up after the wedding feast had begun and the door was shut. But He answered and said 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.'

I never want to hear those words from Jesus, how about you? If He does not return in my lifetime I will die ready to see His lovely face. I will pass from this world with Him in my heart and His dear name on my breath. Nothing in this world will keep me from that moment. God knows my heart, He can read my thoughts, and He knows that I would die before denying Him. He knows that every morning my eyes open in this world that I praise His Holy Name for one more day to glorify Him, and I pray all of you do the same. Look around this world is there any part of it that you would cling to instead of Jesus; ask yourself if anything that this world has to offer you is worth going to hell for. I hope your answer will be a resounding NO!!!

The truth is that Jesus could delay His coming longer than we think, and His coming will catch most people by surprise we need to stay awake and have oil for our lamps. It is also true that some people who profess Christ do not posses Christ and may look like true believers but will hear those dreaded words from Jesus on that day "Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.'

I pray Brothers and Sisters that this will not be true of any of us. God forbid. No religion will assure your place in Heaven, and you cannot get there on anyone else's merits. Keep oil in your lamps and be ready every day to meet your Savior, do not grow weary in well doing and encourage others along the way. Bring as many people home with you as you possibly can, and on that day you will hear these words from Jesus. "Well done good and faithful servant."



Lesbian ministers eager to go in 'Amazing Race'

There weren't any women ministers - much less lesbian ministers - when the Revs. Kate Lewis and Pat Hendrickson were young. Although times have changed, role models are still hard to find, they say, even in the liberal-leaning Episcopal Church. Lewis and Hendrickson, who have been in a relationship since meeting at a religious retreat in 1997, hope to change that with their appearance on "The Amazing Race," the CBS reality show that launches its 12th season tonight.

"We're happy to offer ourselves up to show people that Christians come in many different stripes," said Lewis, a minister at St. Cross Episcopal Church in Hermosa Beach. "Some of us are progressive and inclusive." The potential for a \$1 million prize, along with a globe-spanning adventure, didn't hurt, either. "We are very serious about our relationship with God, and we are very serious about winning this race," said Hendrickson, a minister at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church in Thousand Oaks. "We're not afraid to have a good time, either. There's nothing wrong with having a little fun."

Amid the cast of brothers and sisters, co-workers and heterosexual couples, Lewis and Hendrickson are the only lesbian team ever to compete. The fact that they are both ordained

ministers adds to their allure. The teams travel nearly 50,000 miles by air, sea and land in a physically and mentally demanding race through several countries, including Ireland, Lithuania

Lowe's refuses to call them "Christmas trees," chooses to call them "Family trees"

In an effort to avoid the use of the term "Christmas tree," Lowe's has renamed their Christmas trees and are now calling them "Family trees." In their Holiday 2007 catalog, containing 56 pages of Christmas gifts, Lowe's advertises hundreds of gift items, including scores of "Family trees." In fact, the word "Christmas" only appears two times in the entire holiday catalog. The ads mentioning "Christmas cover only 12 square inches of the 5236 square inches available.

Lowe's even has one of their Family trees turned upside down on a stand. We are not sure what the significance of that is. Lowe's evidently did not want to offend any non-Christians, therefore they replaced "Christmas tree" with "Family tree." Of course, if Christians are offended that is evidently ok. An on-line search of Lowe's does reference some "Christmas" items. In fact, a word search of their Web site gives the exact same number 174 of the word "Christmas" as it does the word "holiday." Most of the items mentioning Christmas appear to use the promotional line given by the manufacturer. Their Holiday 2007 catalog features scores of products, including lights, wreaths, trees, and yard decorations. Most people would associate these items with Christmas, but not Lowe's! Except for two obscure references, they refer to everything in their catalog as "holiday."

How to Know When the Emerging Church Shows Signs of Emerging in Your Church

comfort me." No matter how strong and mean you are my friend it will not protect you in the end. For every knee will bow and every tongue will confess Jesus is Lord. In this new year give it a try Trust in Jesus, not yourself. It will be hard at first but I guarantee that you will like it.

Much of western Bangladesh is in ruins after a powerful cyclone smashed into the impoverished nation with huge waves, severe winds and torrential rains. Cyclone Sidr is the second-worst storm to ever hit disaster-prone Bangladesh. After making landfall in the Sudarban Islands, it swept north over the capital Dhaka. Wind speeds of 140-155 miles an hour were recorded as the storm -- visible from space as a huge swirling white mass that moved north from the Bay of Bengal -- left a trail of devastation in poor rural areas.

Local businessman Mollik Tariqur Rahman told one reporter that 80 percent of the homes in his village had been flattened. "I cannot describe how devastating it was. It was like doomsday, the most frightening five hours of my life. I thought I would never see my family again," he said. The death toll of 3,000 has been rapidly rising since the cyclone struck Thursday morning. The loss of life would be much higher if the government had not evacuated over 600,000 people who lived near the coast. This was the largest evacuation in Bangladesh's history.

In the past three years, I have reported several times about the incredible spike in tropical storm activity. Records have been smashed in every region that is visited by these types of storms. Global warming can't be an explanation for the upsurge we are seeing today. If there is some connection to climate change, we should expect a more gradual rise in the odds of seeing deadly weather events of all types.

To give you folks a perspective of the intensity and frequency of tropical systems, I've compiled a list of storms that stand out in the headlines:

- 2004 Japan was hit by a record number of typhoons.
- 2004 Florida was hit by a record number of hurricanes.
- 2004 Cyclone Catarina 1st South Atlantic cyclone to reach a hurricane strength
- 2005 Katrina was the most costly hurricane in history.
- 2005 Rita was the most powerful Atlantic storm as measured by barometric pressure.
- 2005 Atlantic hurricane watchers recorded 27 storms, the most ever in one season.

2006 - Larry was the most powerful tropical system to hit Australia in 31 years. 2006 - Monica topped Larry as the most intense cyclone ever to impact Australia. 2006 - Typhoon Saomai was the most powerful storm to hit Communist China. 2006 - Ioke - first recorded Category 5 hurricane to develop in the central Pacific

2007 - Cyclone Gonu - strongest tropical cyclone on record in the Arabian Sea. 2007 - The first time two Category 5 Atlantic storms made landfall in one season. 2007 - The first time an Atlantic and Pacific hurricane hit on the same day. 2007 - Humberto - fastest storm ever to go from depression to full-scale hurricane 2007 - Sidr - Second-strongest storm to hit Bangladesh since records began in 1877

I keep asking myself, "Where is this trend going?" If it was just a matter of bad luck, at

some point, the law of averages would even things out and return us to a more normal pattern. If the pattern continues into 2008 and 2009, even the must cynical end-time critic would have to wonder whether Bible prophecy is the driving force behind these storms.

I believe prophecy is the logical reason for the number of record tropical storms. God warned that the calling card of the tribulation hour will be an increase in natural disasters.

I have a theory why hurricanes, cyclones, and typhoons are such a stand out over events like earthquakes, tornadoes and floods. Without a doubt, we are the most warned generation in all of human history. Cyclone Sidr only killed a little more than a thousand people because the population was warned to flee. A less powerful storm killed 300,000 people in 1970 because they did not know what was coming their way. Because of our ability to disseminate information about all things related to prophecy, God may be selecting certain end-times signs to stand out from others.

The most watched last-days indicator is earthquakes. If three strong seismic events occur within in a short period of time, even the godless media would perk up its ears. Jesus said He was coming as a surprise, so it would be counterproductive to have a huge number of massive earthquakes directly ahead His return. End-time components like hurricanes, moral decline, and global government are better indicators because they tend to get less attention.

If the Lord is using tropical storms as a key warning sign, the massive surge of global activity would seem to suggest the end times are very near. Even at the door.

"And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth" (Lk. 21:25-26).

This Months Bible Moment

Ask and receive

This month I want to share what I call a kingdom key for the new year. What is a kingdom key you ask? It is a series of scriptures that tell us how to succeed in this world for the kingdom of God. Now before you get on my case and call me a name it and claim it pastor read and re-read this teaching. This is about what Jesus said about our asking and receiving. Or maybe it is better phrased, what Jesus said about why we ask and do not receive. Three times in the Gospel John Jesus tells us ask and you will receive. So if this is the case why are so many Christians in need. I am not just talking about money here, people! So many Christians in the world today are in need spiritually. They are at their (notice their) wits ends. Except for small pockets there is very little power left in the church. John 14:12-14 (NLT)¹²"The truth is, anyone who believes in me will do the same

works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. ¹³You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, because the work of the Son brings glory to the Father. ¹⁴Yes, ask anything in my name, and I will do it! The key here, ishe who believes in Jesus. He who believes will 1) do greater things and works and 2) will ask anything in Jesus name and He will do it! Of course there is a catch, "because the work of the Son brings glory to the Father." So if you feel you believe in Jesus and ask for a new car, unless it will bring glory to the Father don't count on getting it.

Lets go on: John 15:6-9 (KJV) ⁶If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. ⁷If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. ⁸Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. This is a two way street; we must abide in Jesus and His words must abide in you. Be honest what is your life like? Do you truly abide with Jesus. If you do then every move and action you make in this world is automatically controlled by the old saying "What would Jesus do?" Does this control your life or do you? Second is Jesus words must abide in you. The Greek here means A primary verb; to stay (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy):-abide, continue, dwell, endure, be present, remain, stand, tarry. This does not mean blown by every wind of doctrine, it does not mean following the latest and greatest new "word" from some new "mighty" man of God. Nope! it means enduring, remaining, standing firm on the pure and simple word of God. Do you do that? But again there is a catch, "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples." Again, it is to bring glory to our Father in heaven and to help us be fruitful. The most interesting thing here to me is that the final comment in this line "so shall ye be my disciples." The way I read this is that by bringing glory to our Father in heaven and by bearing much fruit for the kingdom we become disciples for Jesus. Again I have to ask where do you stand? If you are not glorifying the Father I heaven and not being fruitful how can you be a disciple of Christ? So if we want to ask whatever we want and get that prayer answered again it must glorify the Father and must in some way help us bear fruit. Have you figured out yet this goes totally against the name it and claim it gospel?

Continuing; John 16:23-24 (NLT)At that time you won't need to ask me for anything. The truth is, you can go directly to the Father and ask him, and he will grant your request because you use my name. You haven't done this before. Ask, using my name, and you will receive, and you will have abundant joy. Ok, before I go any further please read from verse 16 to understand the "at that time". Jesus is referring to the time that follows His death, burial and resurrection. I.E. Jesus is referring to the time from His ascension to heaven to the time when He returns. I.E. Now! So Jesus says that today we can go directly to the Father in heaven and ask. Jesus even went even further and said our request will be granted because we use His name. This blows all kinds of holes in the Catholic doctrine that Mary is our interceder. Jesus did not say that the Father would answer our request because "Mary went and asked for us." Nope we can go to the Father directly and ask in Jesus name. So my friends if you are asking anything of the Father in heaven through or in anyone's name beside Jesus do not expect it to be answered. Sorry, it is God's word not mine.

If you want 2008 to be a better year with your prayers heard and answered you should follow the simple Biblical sound program. WWJD must be your true battle cry not lip service. Finally <u>you</u> must go directly to the Father using Jesus name, not through some other interceder!

Aflame for God

(By Smith Wigglesworth).

The word that I have for you is in the 7th verse of Heb. chapter 1, "And of the angels He saith, Who maketh His angels spirits, and His ministers a flame of fire."

His Ministers are to be flames of fire! It seems to me that no man with a vision, especially a vision by the Spirit's power, can read that wonderful verse without being kindled to such a flame of fire for his Lord that it seems as if it would burn up everything that would interfere with his progress. A flame of fire! A perpetual fire; a constant fire; a continual burning; a holy, inward flame, which is exactly what God's Son was in the world. I can see this—that GOD HAS NOTHING LESS FOR US THAN TO BE FLAMES! It seems to me that if Pentecost is to rise and be effective, it must have a living faith, so that His great might and power flows through us until the life becomes energised, moved and aflame for God.

The import of our message is that the

HOLY GHOST HAS COME TO MAKE JESUS KING.

It seems to me that the seed, which is an eternal seed—that life that was given to us when we believed—was of such a nature of resurrection power that I see a new creation rising with a kingly position, and I see that when the Holy Grost comes, it is to crown Jesus King. Not only is the King to be within but all the glories of the kingly manifestations are to be brought forth. Oh, for Him so to work in us, melting us, until a new order rises, moved with His compassion. I see that we can come into in the order of God where the vision becomes so much brighter, and where the Lord is manifesting His glory with all His virtues and gifts, and all His glory seems to fill the soul who is absolutely dead, and alive to Him. There is much talk about death, but there is a death which is so deep in God that out of that death God brings the splendour of His life and all His glory.

An opportunity for being a flame of fire for God came when I was travelling from Egypt to Italy. It was quite true what I now tell you. On the ship and everywhere God had been with me. A man on the ship suddenly collapsed, his wife was in a terrible state and everybody else seemed to be. Some said that it had come to the end—but oh, to be a flame, to be indwelt by the living Christ. We are a back number if we have to pray for power, if we have to wait until we feel a sense of His presence. The Baptism of the Holy Ghost is come upon you. "Ye shall have power after that the Holy Grost is come upon you !" Within you there is a greater power than there is in the world. Oh, to be awakened out of our unbelief into

on the authority of the blessed Book! So in the name of Jesus I rebuked the devil, and to the astonishment of the man's wife and himself, he was able to stand. He said, "What is this? It is going all over me. I have never felt anything like this before." For from the crown of his head to the soles of his feet the power of God shook him.

God has given us authority over the power of the devil. Oh, that we may live in the place where the glory excelleth ! It would make anyone a flame of fire.

Who is the express image of God has come to our human weaknesses to change them and us into a Divine likeness, so that by the power of His might, we may not only overcome, but rejoice in the fact that we are more than overcomers. God wants you to have the last part—"MORE than overcomers!" The baptism of the Spirit has come for nothing less than to possess the whole of our life. It sets up Jesus as King, and nothing can stand in His holy presence when He is made King. Everything will wither before Him. I feel I come to a convention like this to stir you up and help you to know that the inheritance of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. Praise the Lord ! And in the Holy Ghost order we have to come behind in no gift.

This same Jesus has come for one purpose that He might be so made manifest in us that the world shall see Him, and we must be

to reflect such a holy Jesus. We cannot do it with cold indifferent experiences and we never shall. My dear wife used to say, "Alice what kind of a meeting have you had ?" Alice would say, "You ask father, he always has a good time!" His servants are to be FLAMES. Jesus is life, and the Holy Ghost is the breath, and He breathes through us the life of the Son of God, and we give it to others. and it giveth life everywhere.

You should have been with me in Ceylon! It was in a Wesleyan Chapel. In this Wesleyan Chapel they said, "You know four days are not much to give us." "No" I said, "but it is a good share." They said, "What are we going to do, because we are not touching the people at all." I said, "Can you have a meeting early in the morning at eight o'clock?" They said they would, so I said: "We will tell all the mothers who want their babies to be healed to come, and all the old people over 70 to come, and then after that we will hope to have an address to the people to make them ready for the Holy Ghost."

Oh, it would have done you all good to see 400 mothers with their babies! It was fine! And then

to see 150 old black people with their white hair come to be healed. I believe that you need to have come to be nealed. I believe that you need to have something more than smoke to touch people, you need to be a burning light for that. His ministers must be flames of fire. There were thousands out-side to hear the Word of God. There were about 3.000 people crying for mercy at once. I tell you it was a sight.

it was a sight. From then the meetings rose to such an extent that every night 5,000 to 6,000 gathered there after I had preached in a temperature of 110. Then you had to minister to these people. But I tell you a flame of fire can do anything. Things change in the fire. This is Pentecost. But what moved me more than anything was this—and I say it this morning with thought and with a broken spirit because I

would not like to mislead anybody— there were hundreds who tried to touch me, they were so im-pressed with the power of God that was present, and they testified everywhere that with a touch they were healed. And it was NOT the virtue of Wigglesworth—it was the same faith that was with those at Jerusalem when they said that Peter's shadow would heal them.

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Now, beloved, my time is coming to a close but you can have something in three minutes that you can carry with you into glory. What do you want ? Is anything too hard for God ? God can meet you now. God sees inwardly, He knows all about you, nothing is hidden from Him and He can satisfy the soul and give you a spring of eternal blessing that will carry you right through.
