GOD'S ABILITY TO MEET ALL THE NEEDS IN LIFE

2 Timothy 4:1-18

Introduction

- His supply for our need. Phil. 4:19
- His supply for our wants. Ps. 23:1
- His supply for our desire Ps. 37:4
- His supply for all things. Romans 8:32

1. Vs. 9. EMOTIONAL NEEDS: Paul needed companionship with others "Come shortly unto me." God supplies our need of 'loneliness.' We need fellowship with other believers. Our basis of fellowship with other believers is our basis of fellowship with Jesus Christ.

2. Vs 13. PHYSICAL NEEDS: Paul needed comfort for the body “The cloak that I left at Troas with Carpas, when thou comest, bring with thee” God supplies the comfort for the body, we can function better spiritually when we are comfortable physically.

3. Vs 13. MATERIAL NEEDS: Paul needed continuation in purpose (Mission) “...And the books, but especially the parchments.” Paul needed his books for study, and the parchment for writing letters to the churches. We need to take in thorough study and to give through our witnessing.

4. Vs 14. MORAL NEEDS: Paul needed control from God “Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil, the Lord reward him according to his works.” If we do not have God’s control in our lives we will seek to get revenge on those who do us wrong. Paul allowed God to reward him according to his works.

5. Vs 16,17. SPIRITUAL NEEDS: “...No man stood with me... the Lord stood with me,” At Paul’s first appearing before the court of Rome, he had no man to appear with him. All forsook him. There are times we feel forsaken, but God will stand with us at all times and during all circumstances.

6. Vs 18. VOCATIONAL NEEDS: Paul needed conquest by his Lord. “And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil works, and will preserve unto His heavenly kingdom.” If we submit ourselves to God He will deliver us unto Himself. CHINA:

Executed for Distributing Bibles

When 34-year old Jiang Zongxiu went to her neighboring market last June in Guizhou Province, China. Along with her mother-in-law, Jiang went through the marketplace, taking opportunities to hand out Bibles and Christian literature and telling people about Jesus. Only this day they had an encounter with the Chinese police. The two Christian women were handcuffed together and brought to the police station. They were interrogated throughout the evening of the 17th. The next morning they were sentenced by the Public Security Bureau (PSB) to 15 days incarceration for "suspected spreading of rumor and disturbing the social order." Jiang and her mother-in-law knew the risk of spreading Christian literature in communist China. Both had been active in their church for more than 10 years and dared to go forth. Even when they were arrested, interrogated and sentenced to serve 15 days, they were willing to accept the consequences of their actions—all from a government that claims to have "freedom of religion." But it was not enough for the PSB to arrest and beat these two Christian women for the crime of passing out Christian literature. In the afternoon of June 18th, Mrs. Jiang Zongziu was pronounced dead by the PSB office of Tongzi County. They claimed she died of "natural causes." The fact is she was beaten to death. The Voice of the Martyrs has received video testimony from the surviving family, photos of Jiang body showing her bruised body, and a copy of the actual arrest document. All of this had to be smuggled out of China as the authorities continue to attempt to hide their systematic persecution of Christians. An international campaign is now under way on behalf of the surviving family.

Like China, like America. Can you read this and react to it if you wish?. In China they are killed physically, in America, they are killed spiritually. In America, they are not allowed to talk about their faith in public. In China, they are not allowed to publicly share the scriptures. These are terrifying and breathe choking event, serving as harbinger of the end of the age, and the end of human race. **Pastor Amakor, Owerri Nigeria**

CAN GOD STILL USE YOU WHEN YOU FALL? OR GOD'S FIVE R'S

Ok, before we get too far into this I must state for the record I do not believe the "we fall down, we get up" theology. OH, yes we are all humans but the Lord makes it plain and clear in His word what He wants. [1 Peter 1:15-16 \(KJV\)](#)¹⁵But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; ¹⁶Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. Our Lord has a call on our lives and we cannot accomplish it if we are conforming to the world. We, as pastors, teachers and everyday Christians must be careful not to condemn people before they have a chance to get back on their feet. Just the other day I was talking to a young woman who had gotten a divorce. Sadly, her ex-husband was a man of God whom she claimed had been abusive to her physically. Notice I said "claimed" because I have not heard both sides of the story yet. My point here is that another pastor in our lovely community told her she could never again marry because she would be committing adultery. So her reaction was to never go back to that church or any other church that I am aware of. In other words the pastor condemning her did not drive her to Jesus, but away. We as leaders and everyday Christians should not be so quick to condemn someone that we put a wedge between them and Jesus. That is not what we are supposed to be about. I have seen the Lord grab people up by their boot straps (we in Wyoming) and restore them. But those people had to want to be restored.

I am not a perfect human being. In fact if it was not for my Lord and Savior and the gift He gave me in my lovely wife, I would be in hot water all the time. In my youth and young adult times of my life I made many mistakes. Ok, truthfully, some of the things I did would make your hair gray. As I told Mary just the other day. When I look back at the many things I did it was only the hand of God that kept me alive to do His work. But the Lord has restored me over the years and has been able to use me greatly. No, I am not anyone special. Jesus is the only one who deserves the glory. I am only a humble and holy vessel He can use. Oh, yes, by the way He is still working on both those things in me, I have a long way to go before I am where He wants. But through His love and grace He has opened many, many doors for the ministry He has allowed Mary and I to run.

Can God still use you when you fall? The answer is up to you. Will you let him do the repair work He needs to do? Will you let Him refine you and mold you into what He wants, or are you a stodgy old stick stuck in the clay? Slowly being preserved. So one day your fossils can be found just as you always were and always will be. You see it is very interesting how our God works. If you study any earth science you will find that when anything organic is put in clay it will be preserved. The clay does not allow air, water and rotting bacteria to attack the material. God uses the example of the potters wheel for us. The potter (God - Jesus) can mold you into what He needs to restore you and again use you for his purpose. But just like the clay you must be ready. Have you ever watched a potter work? He gets a mass of clay and works it in his hands before he puts it on the potters wheel. He has to work some of the resistance out of the clay to be able to use it. When he gets ready to make something he slams the clay onto the wheel with

great force. This serves two purposes, the first is to breakdown the clays final resistance to being worked, the second is to force the clay to stay on the wheel for the final molding.

Yes God can use you again after you have fallen but He must take you through a time of, **R**epentance, **R**ecovery, **R**econstruction, **R**efining and finally **R**estoration before you are ready to return to this service. Read 2 Samuel Chapter 8, here you will see the process of the great fall of David and how God restored him. But you will also see that there was a price for his fall. If you just look at the family tree of our Lord you will see thieves, murders, prostitutes etc. If God can use them to bring Jesus to this world for us don't you think He can use you with all your faults and problems.

You just need to give yourself over to Jesus 100% and let Him bring you through the 5 "R's".
Repentance: Paul says a **2 Corinthians 7:10 (KJV)** ¹⁰For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death. Until we have that Godly sorrow in our hearts, that pain that lets us know we have done wrong, then we can have no true repentance. We must get to the point we feel as if our sin is our vomit and we do not want to return to it.

Recovery: Jesus said: **Matthew 22:39 (KJV)** ³⁹And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Until you forgive yourself you can not forgive others.

Reconstruction: Malachi through the Lord told us: **Malachi 3:7 (KJV)** ...Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith the LORD of hosts. We must allow the Lord to rebuild us. But the only way that can happen is for us to return to the start with the Lord. Return to our first love.

Refining: **Jeremiah 18:4-6 (KJV)** ⁴And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it. ⁵Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ⁶O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel. You must let the Lord refine you and mold you into His image or you will fall again. Remember satan is like a roaring lion searching whom he may devour.

Then

He will **RESTORE** you.

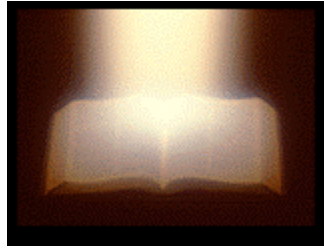

This Months Bible Moment

This was the way I felt again this morning when I read "A legal battle in Dover, Pa., over the teaching of evolution and "intelligent design" has focused new attention on the issue, as have recent proposals in Kansas to change how evolution is taught there." It had to be over five years ago I was invited by our local church groups to speak to the school board here in lovely Pinedale. The debate between whether God created us or we evolved from the ooze. Now I could go on and on about this but as a Christian you either believe God or man which will it be. I believe God!! He said **Genesis 1:1-2 (KJV)** ¹In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. ²And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. Amen. ²⁶For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: ²⁷And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet. ²⁸And even as they did not like to retain God in *their* knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; ²⁹Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, ³⁰Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, ³¹Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: ³²Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

You see we were warned 2000 years ago what happens when we let our E.I.B. educated idiot box (brain) rule us and not our hearts. TEACHING OF THE MONTH

ONE THING!

There are several scriptures that talk about ONE THING, but in this message I want to pick up only three that deal with THREE DIFFERENT THINGS, BUT TALK OF ONE THING.

First; [Psalms 27:4](#) "One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and inquire in his temple. ONE THING HAVE I DESIRED OF THE LORD. The first point we are going to look at in this scripture is this: One thing have I desired of the Lord. Whenever you hear of ONE THING, it usually means that there is more than

one thing. There might be two, five, ten, or a hundred or more things. OF ALL THE THINGS DAVID COULD DESIRE OF THE LORD, HE CHOSE ONLY ONE THING. He could have desired two things, or many things, but he chose one thing. Some times we desire so many things of the Lord but God does not grant them to us; why? WE ARE MISSING THIS ONE THING DAVID DESIRED OF THE LORD.

There is one thing, which you have to desire of the Lord, which David did. ALL THE REST IS WRAPPED IN THIS ONE THING. The problem is that we don't see them in this one thing. David could have desired things he needed in his daily life as a person; father, husband and king but he realized that though those things were important, the most important thing in his life had to be chosen. We are living in the world whereby we have to make choices and decisions what we choose and decide is very important. All decisions will have consequences, if we make right decisions right consequences will follow if wrong decisions then wrong consequences. Among all the things you might need or desire of the Lord what is it that you can call ONE THING I DESIRE OF THE LORD? There must be one thing you desire of the Lord as David did.

SECOND POINT: THAT WILL I SEEK AFTER David says I will seek after this ONE THING I DESIRED OF THE LORD. That will I seek after. He did not say he would ask, or that he would wait on the Lord to do it to me. He said, "I will seek after". SEEKING does not take one minute, or one day, you seek and seek and seek until you find it. The bible says seek and you shall find. That which you desire you will take all the time, effort and strength to seek, that which you desire you will do anything you can to seek it. WHAT IS THAT ONE THING? THAT I MAY DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE. One thing, which David desired of the Lord, was that he might dwell in the House of the Lord all the days of his life. Not to visit but dwell. Not to enter but dwell. Not for a few days, months or years BUT ALL the days of His life. One thing that we must desire of the Lord is TO DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD FOR EVER. When we talk of spiritual life we are dealing with eternal life. John 3:16 says: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" THE PURPOSE OF SALVATION IS TO BRING US INTO GOD'S HOUSE OF THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF OUR LIVES. The same David said in Psalms 23:6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever. David sought a permanent relationship with the LORD, which is what we need to do. He says goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life then I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. It is a choice which one has to make on a daily basis not just once but every day when you wake up make that decision because there are a lot of things which can take us out of the house of the Lord. Let us dwell in the house of the Lord, God's presence and Kingdom That is where God dwells. That is where God's presence is, God's kingdom. WHAT WAS DAVID DOING IN THE HOUSE OF GOD? 1. TO BEHOLD THE BEAUTY OF THE LORD. What does beholding the beauty of the Lord mean? It means worshipping and praising God, to have an intimate relationship with God, and have communion with him, meditating on his greatness and goodness. The primary purpose for us to be in the house of the Lord is that we should worship him, beholding his beauty. There is no more joyful thing you can do in God's house than gazing on God and meditating on him. Jesus said in [Matthews 6:33](#) "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you". Seeking first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness will help us to dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of our lives. 2. TO INQUIRE IN HIS TEMPLE The word to inquire means to get information, knowledge, direction, and guidance. In simple terms it means to get God's Word, revelations or to pray. BUT LET ME TELL YOU SOMETHING. Most of the Christians dwell on prayer, yes we need to pray, but prayer must be as a result of our relationship with God, it should be out of the relationship. The most important thing is building our relationship with God. 2nd scripture [Luke 10:42 \(41-42\)](#) [And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.](#) ONE THING IS NEEDFUL Jesus said: Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: But ONE THING is needful and Mary has chosen that good part. What was the one thing that was needful? SITTING AT THE FEET OF JESUS AND HEARING HIS WORD. JESUS SAID NO MAN SHALL LIVE BY BREAD ALONE BUT BY EVERY WORD, WHICH COMES FROM THE MOUTH OF GOD. The word I speak to you is spirit and life.

The word is the Truth and you shall know the truth and the truth shall set you FREE. Martha was busy doing service unto Jesus while Mary was sitting at the feet of Jesus hearing him speaking. Many times we spend much of our time serving God but we don't have enough time to be in His presence, I believe Jesus wants us to be with him more than us being busy in the name of doing a service unto him. The Bible says in [Mark 3: 14-15;14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, 15 And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:](#) Jesus first called the twelve that they should be with him, then that He might send them. Relationship comes first then the commission comes. 3rd SCRIPTURE: [PHILIPPIANS 3: 13-14 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.](#) THIS ONE THING I DO David said one thing I desired of the Lord IS TO DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD FOR EVER. There is only one thing to desire of the Lord and all are wrapped in this. Jesus said one thing, which is NEEDFUL. There is only one needful thing that is, to sit at Jesus' feet and hear His word all other needs are wrapped in this. PAUL SAYS ONE THING I DO. What is this one thing Paul does. FORGETTING THOSE THINGS THAT ARE BEHIND AND REACHING FORTH UNTO THOSE THINGS, WHICH ARE BEFORE. Paul talks of two dimensions here: First: Those things which are BEHIND. Things, which have already taken place, the past. Both BAD & GOOD. Paul doesn't want to live in the past. Forgetting those things, which are behind. WHY, because the past can be an obstacle to the present and future. The past is a closed chapter, you can't change the past, but you can learn from the past. Don't allow the past to pull you down. Forget your past for there is a future for you which is in the hands of God [Jeremiah 29:11 says God knows the plans He has for us to give us a future, not to destroy us.](#) The second point: AND REACH FORTH UNTO THOSE THINGS, WHICH ARE BEFORE. Paul knows that there are things, which are before Him. God has bestowed promises before us, things that have not yet come to pass.
