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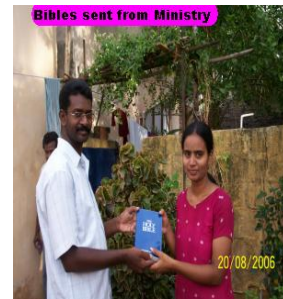
Praise's of the Month

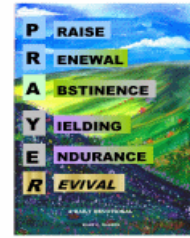

The Word Speaks!

Proverbs 8:13 (KJV) ¹³The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogance, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.

Mary's Thoughts for the Month **DIVINE APPOINTMENTS**

“When the Spirit of God has shed abroad the love of God in our hearts, we begin deliberately to identify ourselves with Jesus Christ’s interests in other people, and Jesus Christ is interested in every kind of man there is.”

—Oswald Chambers

I love this quote by Oswald Chambers. When we begin deliberately to identify ourselves with Christ's interests in other people wonderful things will happen. Jay and I have a common saying we use when we experience delays of any kind and that is "Delay is not denial." Usually when we experience a delay in our schedule it is because the Lord has arranged a divine appointment for us. We have learned by trial and error to let the Lord control our schedules and our contacts.

Let me give you some real life examples. One night we were in a hurry to get to a nearby town to have dinner, we were down to nothing in the way of groceries and when you are out in the middle of an oil field there are no grocery stores nearby. For one reason or another we were delayed all day trying to get to town, so when we finally got away the only thing we could do was hope to make it to the little town of Boulder Wyoming to have dinner at the restaurant there before they closed. We were nearly out of the oil field when we encountered an entire group of rig hands whose car had broken down. It was well below zero out and they were hoping that someone from their rig would notice that they were late and come to see why. Well, of course we decided to take them all the way back into the field to their rig, luckily we had a big Suburban and could stuff them all in. In doing so, we were able to show a group of rough-necked men the love of Jesus for half an hour, and they were a captive audience. After we dropped them off safely at their rig it was back to Boulder for us.

We were sure the restaurant would be closed, but amazingly enough it was open. The only two people there were the cook, Randy who had recently lost his mother, and the waitress, Niki. We were well acquainted with both of them, and had tried unsuccessfully to share the gospel with them many times. I say unsuccessfully because they were always busy when we visited with them and there were always interruptions from other patrons. This night was very different, glory to God, because we were the only two patrons and they closed the place as soon as we came in. After dinner Randy came over to sit down with us and talk to us. He said he was having a hard time with his mom's death. Niki stopped what she was doing and sat down to listen. Niki is an interesting character who has many different beliefs including New Age. She embraces a little bit of everything including some Christian beliefs. We were talking to Randy about his mom and found out that she died a believer, what wonderful news! We were then able to tell him how he could see her again. We shared for almost an hour with both of them the good news. Now, neither of them wanted to do much about it right then, but we left them in the hands of the Holy Spirit.

Another time the Lord had a divine appointment for us was when we were in Denver Colorado on our way to St. Louis. We really didn't need gas and so there was no reason for us to stop at the Loaf and Jug, but we decided at the spur of the moment to cap off the gas tank. Shortly after we parked a woman came up to us in obvious distress. She said "I read your license plate and thought you might be able to help me." We have personal plates on two of our vehicles and

they are WWJD, (what would Jesus do). She was obviously familiar with the acronym and decided to test its validity. We said we would be delighted to help her and asked what she needed. She pointed to her old car filled to the brim with belongings and three small children. She went on to explain that she was moving across country to California to start life over with her parents. She hadn't planned properly (or possibly could not have) and had ran out of funds. What she needed was a full tank of gas and some change to call her parents so they could wire her some cash to get all the way there. But what she asked for was prayer, "I have been praying and I know that you must be a people of prayer, because of your license plate, so could you pray for me?" She asked. We said we could and decided to help her in a more tangible way as well. Jay filled up her gas tank then asked how long it had been since she and the kids had a meal. She said they had been eating what little was left of their snack food. We gave her funds enough to get another tank of gas and some food for her and the kids. She thanked us profusely, asked God to bless us, and almost danced back to her car. **Another divine appointment orchestrated by God in the answer to someone's prayer.**

Every day we have opportunities—divine appointments—to introduce broken and lost people to Christ and plant seeds of faith. But many Christians remain unaware of these divine opportunities, or they stumble over their fear of rejection and feelings of inadequacy. The fact is, in order to participate in God's redemptive plan for unsaved people, we must view faith-sharing opportunities as a calling, rather than as mere coincidence, and every delay as a possible divine appointment.

I will share one last instance with you. We were on our way to Rock Springs one day, again no matter what we seemed to do to get out of Pinedale in a timely manner we were continually delayed. At long last we hit the road. Midway there we encountered a group of college kids, five in all, broke down on the side of the road. They were on Spring break from Colorado and were on their way home when their car broke down. Once again, we were thankful for our large Suburban and stuffed all of them in it and went off to Rock Springs. They were so thankful and were sure that once they arrived at Rock Springs one of the young men could call his parents and help would be on the way. Jay handed them the cell phone and told them all to call their parents and let them know what was going on. One of their dads ended up talking to Jay and thanking him. Jay was also able to give the dad some assurance they were all fine and we would deliver them to the 'Flying J' truck stop where the dad would meet them. After they were finished calling they commented on what "nice and happy" people we were and wondered why. Just try to tell me this wasn't a divine appointment. We were able to tell them we were happy because we served a risen Savior! They had to listen, because again we had a captive audience. They were very attentive and quite a joy to be around. When we got to the 'Flying J' we tried to give them some cash for a meal or two but they assured us they had plenty of money and would be fine waiting there for their parents.

So, I encourage you brothers and sisters to fully surrender your time and your schedule to the Holy Spirit, and I just know you will never be disappointed that you did. Your life will be a great adventure and you will be able to share the love of Jesus everywhere you go. The Lord will make some divine appointments for you and you will be able to watch in wonder as He does.

The Sad things Department

The Church of England yesterday backed proposals to give millions of unmarried couples who are "living in sin" similar legal rights to their married counterparts. Risking accusations that it was undermining marriage, the Church said that cohabiting couples with children should be granted significant legal protection if they split up. It also argued that those rights should be extended to unmarried couples without children if one of the ex-partners was at risk of suffering a substantial injustice when they separated. Responding to recommendations from the Law Commission, the Church said it wanted to uphold the ideal of marriage but that there was a strong biblical precedent for protecting the vulnerable. Its stance will dismay many Anglicans, who believe that any support for people living together outside marriage will erode the institution. The Church's view also appeared to contradict comments by the Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr Rowan Williams. He said in June that the commission's proposals showed a proper concern for vulnerable people, but those anxious about the needs of a cohabiting partner could already make wills and draw up legal contracts. He said that marriage, which was the healthiest environment in which to bring up children, had "suffered a long process of erosion" and that the commission's proposals would further add to "a prevailing social muddle".

New report documents severe violations of religious freedom in Colombia 09/10/2006

A new report details for the first time the extent of religious freedom violations in Colombia. It outlines at least six clear cases of targeted assassinations of pastors or church leaders, the kidnapping or forced disappearance of at least three others, and the attempted assassination of a pastor that left more than 70 bullets embedded in his body. The report also documents two violent attacks that took place during church services and resulted in four deaths and left 14 worshipers wounded. It shows how these violations are being committed by all actors in the armed conflict, including leftist guerrillas, far right paramilitaries and even members of Colombia security forces.

Pastor's Corner

John 15:18-21 (NLT) "When the world hates you, remember it hated me before it hated you. The world would love you if you belonged to it, but you don't. I chose

you to come out of the world, and so it hates you. Do you remember what I told you? 'A servant is not greater than the master.' Since they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you. And if they had listened to me, they would listen to you! The people of the world will hate you because you belong to me, for they don't know God who sent me.

I know it shouldn't but it bothers me that the two main buzz words in the Christian community are opposites. LOVE AND HATE! It all depends on which side of the fence you are on. Many say love everyone, no matter what sin they are involved in, to get them into the church. Many become islands because they spew hatred about all sin toward mankind. But I want us to get back to where the word of God says we should be. I believe if it is good enough for Jesus it is good enough for me. Jesus made it plain and clear. Belong to the world be loved, belong to Him be hated. How hard is that to understand? Just look at history, every man and woman who truly belonged to the Lord was persecuted. Just look at who is the most popular in the world today. Mighty men and woman of God or those "Christians" who believe we have a Santa Claus God who loves everyone and does not judge us for our sin. The wisest man to ever live gave us the insight to how God looks at sin. **Proverbs 6:16-19 (NLT)** ¹⁶There are six things the LORD hates—no, seven things he detests: ¹⁷ haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent, a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong, a false witness who pours out lies, a person who sows discord among brothers. Pretty harsh words, our Lord not only hates these things, but detests them and these do not seem that bad to the world, but Solomon says that the Lord detests them. So, what do you think our Lord thinks of the child molester? What do you think our Lord thinks of the Homosexual? What do you think our Lord thinks of the terrorists that kill innocent people? In *the word speaks* this month we see that the fear of the Lord is hating what God hates and loving what God loves. From Jesus' words we see if we belong to Him we will hate what God hates and what the world loves-- SIN! People, we need to get back into the Word of God. Quit listening to the namby-pamby men and woman who tell you, you need to have a better self esteem or you need your best life now. Start listening to the Holy, Pure, good and faithful word of God. Christians today have moved so far from what we should be. Jesus said it again best: **Matthew 10:34-39 (NLT)** ³⁴“Don't imagine that I came to bring peace to the earth! No, I came to bring a sword. ³⁵I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. ³⁶Your enemies will be right in your own household! ³⁷If you love your father or mother more than you love me, you are not worthy of being mine; or if you love your son or daughter more than me, you are not worthy of being mine. ³⁸If you refuse to take up your cross and follow me, you are not worthy of being mine. ³⁹If you cling to your life, you will lose it; but if you give it up for me, you will find it. I again challenge you to show me in these words of Jesus where He is telling us; we are here to have our best life now; or that we are to accept sinners as they are because Jesus did; or just conform and not cause any waves? No! Jesus is telling you and I that if we love anyone or anything more than Him we are not

worthy of being His. So where do you stand on sin? Where do you stand on holiness? Where do you stand on being different from the world? Where do you stand on preaching and teaching the truth no matter what the world thinks? But, most of all where do you stand on sending your neighbor, co-worker, friend, relative, spouse, child, straight to hell because you want to love them into the church rather than preach the truth that will convict them of their sins and save their eternal soul. Remember Peter's words **2 Peter 2:4 (NLT)** ⁴For God did not spare even the angels when they sinned; he threw them into hell, in gloomy caves and darkness until the judgment day. And God did not spare the ancient world—except for Noah and his family of seven. Noah warned the world of God's righteous judgment. Then God destroyed the whole world of ungodly people with a vast flood. If he didn't spare His own creation, the angels, do you people really think that He is going to spare anyone on this old earth that is living a sinful life?

Let's get back to the word and preach the gospel of Jesus to save souls. That is truly the only business that we have to be concerned with. We do not need to love someone into the church while pretending their sins do not exist. We only need to tell them the gospel truth about Jesus and let the Holy Spirit do the rest.

The Amish Shine Their Light amid darkness and persecution.

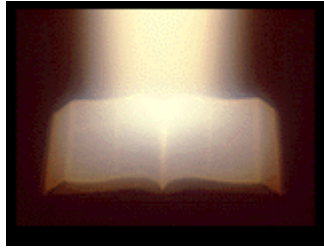
On October 2, Charles Roberts entered a one-room Amish schoolhouse and took ten girls hostage. An hour later, Roberts killed five of his hostages and then killed himself. A community that resists what it regards as the contagions of modernity, falling victim to a very modern kind of violence. Is no one safe from the darkness that covers the world?

But, the difference we see in this community was and is that Christ still shines. A thirteen-year-old Marian Fisher, one of the Amish girls held captive, displayed Christ, she offered to lay her life down for her friends. It was reported that she told Roberts, "Shoot me and leave the other ones loose!"

The deeper truth here is that even in the painful aftermath of the shootings, the Amish continued their witness to the love of Christ, reaching out to Roberts's family, attending Roberts's funeral, comforting his wife and children, and providing for them through a fund established for Roberts's victims and their families. One victim's family even invited the Roberts to their daughter's funeral. In the most dramatic way, they forgave Roberts.

Could you do that my friends? Could you reach out through your agony to the family of the one who caused your troubles. On the cross Jesus said **"Father forgive them for they know not what they do."** Could you? We all could take a lesson on the depth of Christian love from the Amish. They did not let this crush them they did not curse or blame God. They knew where their loved ones would be and used this as an opportunity to try to bring just one more home with them. They knew that they could do nothing for Roberts, his fate was sealed. But, maybe just maybe by turning bad into good they might reach another. Today as I write this the little Amish community is tearing down the one room school house. They are going to use the property for a memorial to the fallen children. I believe they should use it for a memorial to all Christians to remember how we should act in Christ's name.

Esther 4:14 (NLT)

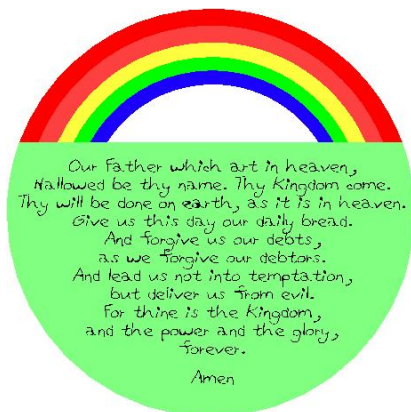
14If you keep quiet at a time like this, deliverance for the Jews will arise from some other place, but you and your relatives will die. What's more, who can say but that you have been elevated to the palace for just such a time as this?"

Mordecai said a mouthful there. Sometimes the simplest words come from those who do not truly know the deep impact they will have. God Spoke to and through Mordecai that day and the rest is history. God had placed Esther there for just this time. God had taken her out of the poverty she grew up in and showed her favor by putting her in the highest position any woman in the kingdom could have. All this was orchestrated by God for one purpose, to save his people. Has God ever placed you in a certain situation for His purpose? Or maybe the question should be are you like Esther and unaware that you have been placed in such a place for a just such a time as this?

This is why it is so important for us to keep the open lines of communication with the Lord so we know what is His will for us. Just the other day old slue foot put a very large carrot in front of Mary and I. No, it would not have taken us from doing the Lord's work. In fact, it had the appearance of being totally the Lord's doing and His handy work. But, don't you hate that but! It was not what the Lord wanted for us. You see Mary and I do not let a day go by without praying "Lord your will be done in our lives". So, just like the situation above we prayed that if it was not from the Lord, that He remove it and He did. My point here is just like the Bible tells us old slue foot can pose as an angel of light, he can also distract us with things that on the surface appear to be from the Lord. The last thing that old slue foot wants is for you and I to be in the Lord's

will for our lives. Because when we are in the Lord's will, we are doing just what, when and where, our Lord and Savior wants.

In Esther's case she still was unsure and told Mordecai to have all the Jews fast for three days and if the King let her speak to him it was God's will for the time. Let's be totally honest, when was the last time you fasted for God's will in your life? Or even more honest do you even want God's will in your life? I can promise you that just like Esther's life yours will change dynamically once you truly enter into the will of the Lord for



your life. Why do you think it was right on top of the list when Jesus taught them to pray. First was praise, "[hallowed by your name](#)"; second was expectation for God's kingdom "[Your kingdom come](#)"; and then third before anything else was "[Your will be done](#)". The other thing we can see from the story of Esther's life is that there are rewards for wanting to be and for being in God's will for your life. Over ten years ago Mary and I learned the lesson that we should always pray to be in God's will for our Lives. Things changed dynamically in our lives. When we actually let our Lord be in total control. Oh! Yes He changed our lives, he took us out of our comfort zone, He created a new life style for us. But, and this is a great but!! But, He has never let us down. He has blessed us abundantly. We have had greater health, greater wealth, greater peace in our lives, greater joy, happiness and satisfaction with our work for the Lord. But, most of all not one single worry because God was in control. You can take this to the bank, you can take this as a fact, that if you pray for the Lords will in your lives everyday good things will happen. But, you must be close enough to the Lord in a personal relationship to know what His will for your life is when it comes.

Esther was very blessed to have Mordecai in her life. She did not fully understand why God had been so mean to her and had taken her out of her home and placed her in the Palace. But, God showed Mordecai "[What's more, who can say but that you have been elevated to the palace for just such a time as this?](#)" Our Lord and Savior will do the same with you if you truly want His will for your life. So many of the big named pastors and teachers in the church today spew the same message "God wants to bless you". Sad part is they just don't have it. They then tell you that for God to bless you, "you have to sow your seed in their ministry to activate it." Show me in the Bible where God comes to even one person and tells them to sow a seed to activate His blessing, ***it isn't there!*** Yes, God wants to bless you, but He cannot unless you are where you need to be and that is in His will. Let's go back to the story of Esther. When it was all said and done Esther was right in the center of God's will for her and her people. How did God reward her? He made her the most powerful woman in the whole kingdom with all the kings riches and power and the Lord elevated Mordecai to the second highest man in the kingdom with all the riches and power that goes along with it. I will not promise you that God will make you a king or queen if you are 100% in His will but I will promise you He will take care of you better than you ever thought possible. I will leave you with this thought. Since Mary and I have been praying the Lords will in our lives we have been blessed abundantly in many ways. We will be totally debt free in a few months. No, that does not mean we have nothing, it means that the Lord has provided a means to own everything we need and not have debt against it. Notice I said what we need, not everything we want. One thing about being in the Lord's will is there is a difference between the Lord providing everything you need and everything you want. He can do the same for you. But the relationship must start with you.

Praise the Lord! I remember coming to London for the first Convention many years ago, and at that time I was in a very strange place, but there were people who were very kind to me. The kindness of the people of God at that time was wonderful.

You probably don't know, but I have had a month or six weeks in Canaan. I have crossed the river of Jordan, been on the lake of Galilee, bathed in the dead sea, drunk at Jacob's well, had a drink at Elijah's fountain, preached on the top of Mount Olives, stood with tears running down my face just opposite Mount Calvary, with hands lifted up and seen the place of sacrifice, passed by the spot where the holy Inn stood of Bethlehem, and as I thought of all the holy associations connected with that land, my heart was melted. God has been very good to me.

One of my favourite texts to-night, is in the 12th chapter of Hebrews. I want to read a few verses there. What a wonderful revelation the Hebrews is to us. I will read the first verse. "Wherefore, seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us looking off unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith." The thought here is Jesus as the Author and Finisher of our faith. Glory to God. What a sight to see our Lord Jesus Christ come forth robed in His own majesty and glory, as no man was ever robed. He is clothed in majesty. What compassion He had when He saw the heaving multitude, when He saw the crowds in need, His heart yearned with compassion. How He handled the bread. Never any man handled bread like Jesus. I can almost look into His face, and see His eyes glisten as He sees the multitude. Praise the Lord! It was lovely to be there, and see these things, but, beloved, it made me cherish the Bible as I have never cherished it before. Why? Because God has given us the assurance that makes our hearts know it is true. If you never see the Holy Land, you can live in the Holy Land and see all the wonderful things, and read of them in your Bible. "Beloved, I want to speak to-night on the Author and the Finisher of our

faith, and I want us to remember that Abraham, and Daniel, and all the prophets, were men of faith. We must not look at the things that have been done in the past, we must look at Jesus the Author and the Finisher of our faith, we must "run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus." We must so look at the Author and the Finisher of our Faith that the same glory and power shall be resting upon us as was upon Him, we must have such grace, such holiness that we shall be landmarks showing His power is upon us. Praise the Lord. Don't stumble at what I am going to say, but I praise God we not only have the abiding presence of the Spirit's power in our midst, but we have the living Word, the living Christ. He is the Author and the Finisher of our faith. He has given to us eternal life, that is if we have His word and believe.

My dear wife has now entered the glory, but during her lifetime she was a great revivalist. She was the preacher. I was staying in a house, and the lady of the house prepared a room and a bed for me to rest upon, as I had just got off the train and was very tired. When I awoke she said, "I want you to lay in my son's bed, I should like him to know you have laid in the bed." I slept in that bed for three nights, and two people slept in the same bed and both got baptised in the Spirit. Hallelujah! I would that everyone who is seeking would get baptised in the same way. That

lady had such a sense of the presence of God that she said, "Lay in my son's bed." As soon as I opened my eyes, I looked across the room, and saw these words, "A man does not fall because he makes a blunder, he falls because he makes a blunder the second time." But God does not want us to fall but to be kept by His grace from falling, and to strive for holiness. I see the Word of God is the living Word, and Jesus is the Author of that word. The Holy Ghost is the enlightener of the Word. If you look at the 1st of Acts, you will see these words, "He gave commandment by the Holy Ghost." This is the Word we have to-night. We shall find as we go on that the Lord Jesus Christ is

THE AUTHOR OF OUR LIFE,

He is the source of our life, our spiritual life, and He is producing holiness.

I am going to stop soon, for I have such respect for my brother who is going to speak. I love him so. I want to leave this word with you. I had intended to speak about the vision, but as my time is short, I cannot speak about it now. I want you to see what David said in the 63rd Psalm, "To see Thy power and Thy glory, so as I have seen it in the sanctuary." Jesus said,

"Father, glorify Thou Me with Thine own self, with the glory which I had with Thee before the world was." The greatest glory that was ever seen was manifested on the Cross. The glory was manifested when Jesus offered Himself "through the eternal Spirit, on the Cross." He said to Judas, "What thou doest, do quickly, and now is the Son of Man glorified. So we see that God was glorified in Jesus, He was reconciling the world unto Himself.

Everyone who has desires to-night for God, believe the Word of God, take Jesus as the Author and the Finisher of your faith. All the desires and purposes of your heart shall be accomplished, because God is faithful. God cannot fail, His word is true. But what is real Pentecost? It is the manifestation of the power of God, the manifestation of the power of the Holy Ghost. Real Pentecost is the manifestation of the signs and wonders, real Pentecost is speaking the Divine utterances, real Pentecost is manifested in those who are determined to know "nothing among men, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified." I say to-night, as I have said before, "Whom have I in Heaven but Thee, and there is none upon earth that I desire beside Thee." He is my all in all. Amen.
